BACKGROUND

Annette's primary duties with the BMV were to work with the Governor's office, state agencies, courts, clerks, prosecutors, judges and law enforcement agencies as it related to motor vehicle traffic laws. Working for the BMV, Annette developed extensive knowledge in customer service, managing employees, working as a project manager, preparing long and short term goals and preparing annual budgets for a state division comprised of 108 employees.

In 2006, Ms. Page joined Entara and is currently assigned as Project Manager for the Indiana Supreme Court, Division of State Court Administration, Judicial Technology and Automation Committee's Electronic Citation and Warning System (eCWS) initiative. Under Annette's management and direction, the eCWS has been deployed to the Indiana State Police as well as approximately 65 other local law enforcement agencies. To date, Indiana has approximately 3,000 law enforcement officers using the eCWS.
